

Student instructions for the
CALS Commencement Ceremony
for Bachelor's and Master's Degree Recipients
April 29 ▪ 7 pm ▪ Stephen C. O'Connell Center

Time

Our ceremony is scheduled for 7 p.m., but that's when everyone is seated and the National Anthem is played. The processional will begin shortly after 6:30 p.m. Your guests should be in their seats before that time. The O'Connell Center gates will open at 5:30 p.m. There will be a recessional of all graduates after the ceremony; you will not be permitted to leave early. Everything should be finished by 9 p.m.

You should arrive at the O'Connell Center with your cap, gown and name card in pristine condition no later than 5:45 p.m. Graduates must enter through Gate 4. Your guests will need to enter from Gate 1. **Please do not fold, bend or otherwise mutilate your name card.** We need the QR code to be readable so your name will appear on the screens when you walk across the stage. Before arriving at the O'Connell Center, please complete the front and back of the card. You will retain this card until you are ready to be individually recognized on the platform during the ceremony.

Regalia

Regalia will be available for pickup at the UF Bookstore beginning on April 17 (you must bring your Gator1 card).

If you will receive Anderson Scholar or CALS Honors Scholar medals, please wear those to graduation along with any honor cords you earned. CALS Honors Scholars will receive their medals at our CALS Scholarship and Leadership Awards Banquet. Students are pre-identified for honor cords based on their upper-division GPA at the end of the fall 2016 semester and whether or not they are completing an honors thesis (for *magna* or *summa cum laude*).

Printed Programs

Each student walking in our ceremony will receive a keepsake program specific to the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences on his or her seat. An abbreviated version of the program will be available for guests as they enter the O'Connell Center.

Because the college is hosting its own ceremony, the University of Florida did not print CALS bachelor's and master's degree students' names in the UF Commencement Program.
