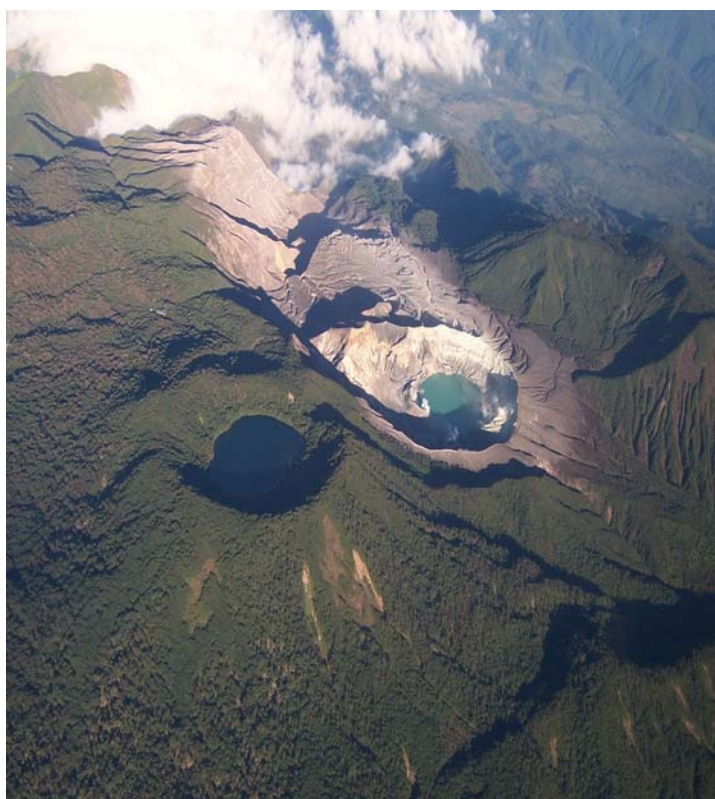
UF in Costa Rica (Spring Break)

Financial Aid

University of Florida students needing financial aid should apply through UF Student Financial Affairs (SFA). Non-UF students needing financial aid must apply to their home institutions.

Scholarships

The deadline for application for TERM scholarships administered by the UF International Center is DATE. Online applications are available at www.abroad.ufic.ufl.edu and at the International Center in 170 Hub.



FEES DUE UPON APPLICATION:

A deposit toward the total cost of the program is required at the time of application, of which \$50 is non-refundable. The remaining fees are due **no later** than 30 days prior to departure.

Students receiving financial aid may defer payment until the disbursement of their financial aid.

IMPORTANT:

Major medical health insurance coverage while outside of the United States is **MANDATORY** for all UF students. Verification of major medical health insurance coverage which meets UF standards is required.
