CALS AI Teaching Integration Award (2025)

Nominations Open: March 1st

Nominations Due: Friday May 2, 2025, to wysocki@ufl.edu



Description: CALS award program to recognize AI Teaching Integration in undergraduate and/or graduate courses. This award commends an instructor or instructional team who has implemented AI solutions within their existing course(s). This award honors creative use of AI in traditionally non-AI courses.

How Recognized: Recognized in IFAS units (departments and centers) and at the annual CALS Teaching Enhancement Symposium.

Award: Memento.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Instructors or instructional teams who integrated AI into UF course(s) in the spring 2024, summer 2024, and/or fall 2024 semesters are eligible for this award. The instructor or instructional team must be the instructor(s) of record, and the course must be identified by a UF course number.
- 2. Nominations may be provided by former students, faculty members, department chairs, and/or higher-level administrators.
 - a. Self-nominations are encouraged.
 - b. The CALS Dean's office will verify the eligibility of the nominee and encourage them to apply for this award.
- 3. The individual or instructional team must be faculty (tenure-track or other *regular* faculty appointment including lecturer, but <u>not</u> OPS appointees) who have been responsible for teaching the course(s) identified above at least one time in spring, summer, or fall 2024.
- 4. The course being used for this award must have an AI designation or be in the process of acquiring and AI designation through the <u>UF AICC</u>. Given the limited number of courses that are currently AI designated we will consider courses just started the process of integrating AI.
- 5. This recognition is designed to serve as a "building" memento for awardees. Awardees are encouraged to also submit for university level awards for AI teaching.
- 6. Individuals or instructional teams who received this award during the **previous two years** are not eligible. Given this is the first year for this award, all CALS faculty are eligible.

Nomination and Application Process:

- Submit completed packets (see Table 1 below) to the CALS Dean's office (<u>wysocki@ufl.edu</u>) by Friday May 2, 2025.
- All sections of the portfolio are to be labeled in header with instructor(s) name(s) and department. Use a 12-point font. The portfolio cannot exceed page limitations.
- All documentation should, wherever possible, address the following **criteria**:
 - Describe how the instructor or the instructional team has integrated AI into a traditionally non-AI course.
 - o Include up to three examples of supporting materials using AI to develop new assignments, experiential learning opportunities, or course content.
- Winners will be notified by May 23 and will be recognized at the annual CALS Teaching Enhancement Symposium on August 12, 2025.
