## PROGRAM

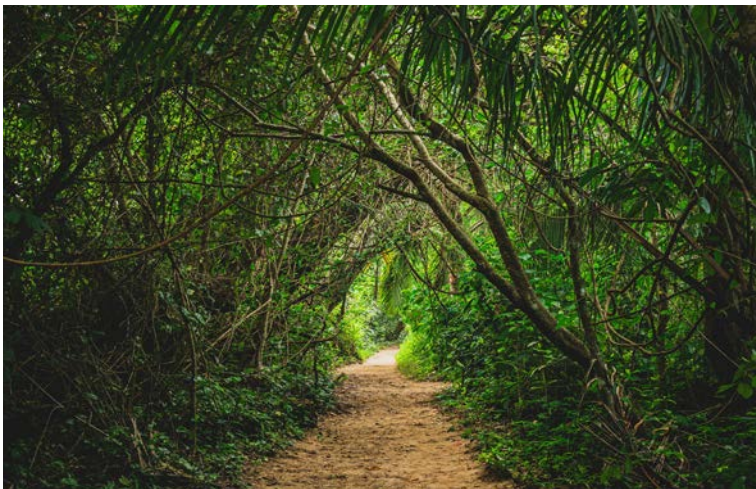

## WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED

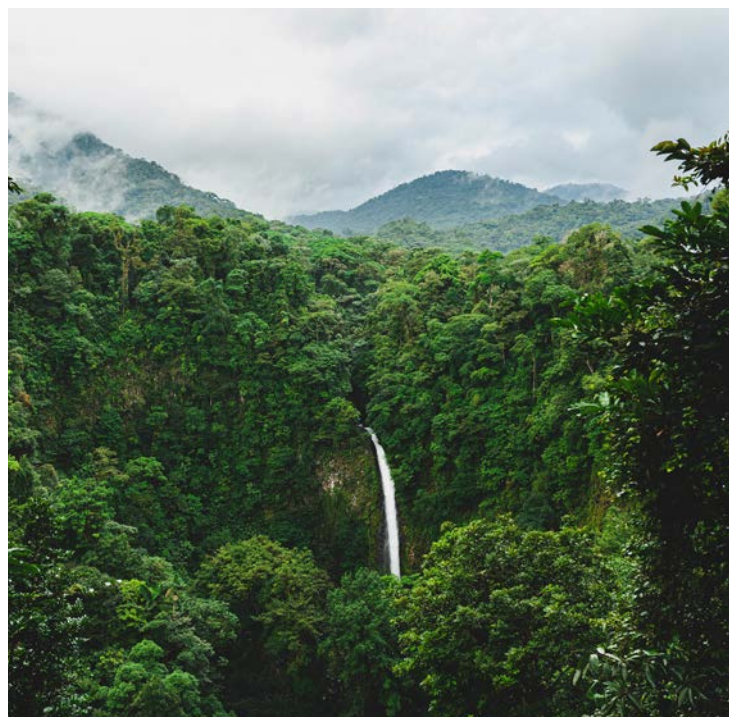
Round-trip airfare, additional personal travel, and personal expenses
