PROGRAM

Founded in 1827, the Rheinische Friedrich-Wilhelms Universität Bonn is considered to be one of Europe's most important institutes of higher education. It is a leading research university with a student population of around 30,000.

ACADEMICS

Exchange students at the University of Bonn can enroll in courses from a variety of academic disciplines, including the Natural Sciences, Social Sciences, and Humanities. Exchange students also have the ability to enroll in special German language and culture courses offered by Bonn's International Office. Language courses are offered at different levels, from A1.1 through B2.2, based on students' existing German language skills. The International Office also offers a course series called "Germany in a Global Context", which is taught in English and provides students an insight into the political, social, and cultural structures of Germany.

LOCATION

The birthplace of Beethoven, the University of Bonn has developed into a lively academic town and cultural center. It is located in the southernmost part of the Rhine-Ruhr region, the largest metropolitan area of Germany, with over 11 million inhabitants. Every spring, usually in April, Bonn comes alive with blooming cherry blossom trees. From Bonn it is also easy to access other German cities, including Cologne (30 minutes) and Düsseldorf (1 hour).

HOUSING

Exchange students can reserve a dorm room in Bonn after being officially accepted to the exchange program. Although there are dozens of different dorm buildings all over the city, all are easily accessible to Bonn's campus by either foot, bike, or public transportation.

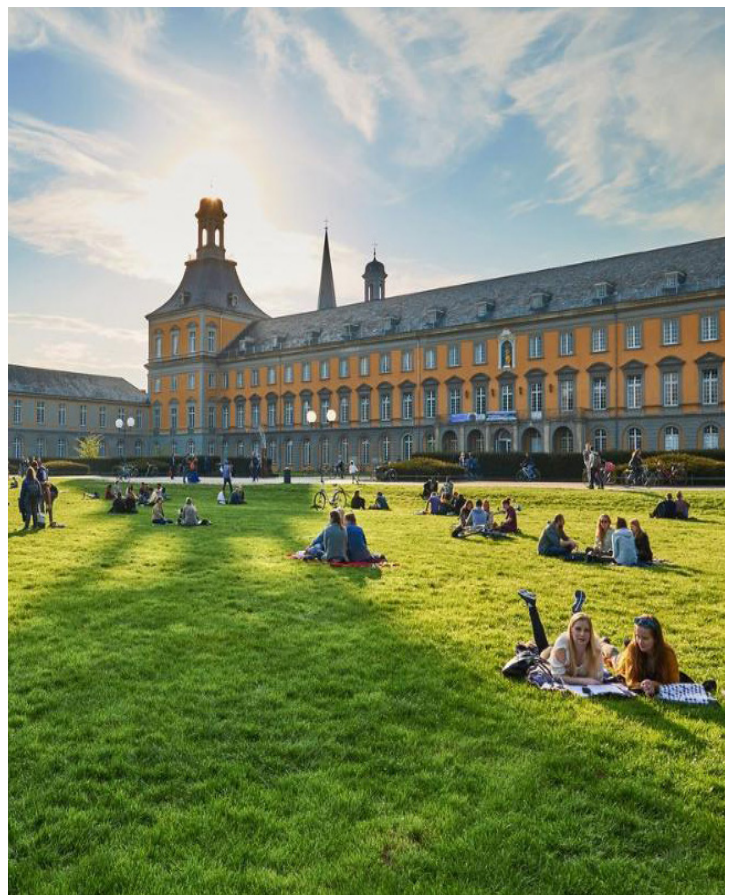

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Open to all majors
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be in good standing

COSTS

By studying on a UF Exchange program, you will pay UF tuition for the semester. However, your housing, meals, and other expenses will be paid directly to the University of Bonn or a third-party. Please see here for UF's current tuition rates and note that exchange students typically enroll in 12-18 credits while abroad. **A \$425 nonrefundable application charge is due at the time of application.**

FINANCIAL AID

Most financial aid that you would receive on campus during the semester can be applied toward the cost of this study abroad program; however, all financial aid eligibility is determined by Student Financial Affairs. You must speak with a financial aid advisor to determine what aid can be applied to the cost of this study abroad program, including scholarships.
