PROGRAM

Hochschule Osnabrück - University of Applied Sciences was founded in 1971 and currently has over 13,000 students. In addition, more than 800 visiting students from over 85 countries study at Osnabrück every year. For UF business students, a semester at HS Osnabrück also brings an opportunity to intern at a multinational firm. Although fluency in the German language is not necessary, it is encouraged that students interested in interning enroll in a German "crash" course upon arriving at Osnabrück.

ACADEMICS

The Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences has a high reputation in the region of Lower Saxony, Germany and far beyond. It is the largest and highest performance university of applied sciences in Lower Saxony, with four departments: Agricultural Sciences and Landscape Architecture; Engineering and Computer Science; Management, Culture and Technology; and Business Management and Social Sciences. It is committed to the approach of a "University of Applied Sciences", staying actively involved in society and valuing research as essential. It also places great emphasis on a close dialog with its economic, social and political environment.

LOCATION

Osnabrück is a beautiful, historic German town of about 170,000 inhabitants with churches and half-timbered houses going back to medieval times. The city has theatres, cinemas, sports facilities and museums; it also hosts a variety of cultural and international events and traditional festivals throughout the year.

HOUSING

The Student Services Osnabrück maintains more than 20 apartment buildings in Osnabrück and an apartment house in Lingen. Some of the rooms and the apartments are also furnished. These rooms are intended for international students who are enrolled in English-language programs and/or have no or limited German language skills



- Must be in good standing

COSTS

By studying on a UF Exchange program, you will pay UF tuition for the semester. However, your housing, meals, and other expenses will be paid directly to the University of Bonn or a third-party. Please see here for UF's current tuition rates and note that exchange students typically enroll in 12-18 credits while abroad. A \$425 nonrefundable application charge is due at the time of application.

FINANCIAL AID

Most financial aid that you would receive on campus during the semester can be applied toward the cost of this study abroad program; however, all financial aid eligibility is determined by Student Financial Affairs. You must speak with a financial aid advisor to determine what aid can be applied to the cost of this study abroad program, including scholarships. 



