PROGRAM

You will visit a variety of agricultural areas including grape, wine, olive, vegetable, wheat and deciduous crop regions, as well as dairy and cheese-making regions. You will see, study, and taste many of these products as you are guided by the owners of these enterprises on comprehensive tours. You will also immerse yourself in the centuries' old Italian cultures and customs. There will be ample opportunity to meet local farmers and vintners and enjoy each region's unique cuisine.

LOCATION

You will visit numerous areas of Italy, including Palermo and Catania in Sicily, Venice, Vicenza, Bologna, Tuscany, Florence, Siena, and Rome.

EXCURSIONS

This program involves extensive travel throughout Italy. In-country transportation is by chartered bus, plane, or train.

HOUSING
