IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

Application deadline is Tuesday, February 20th by 3:27 PM. Return completed applications to 2020 McCarty Hall D attention Jenai Collins. Electronic versions of the application will not be accepted.

The CALS Ambassador program is beginning its 25th year and is recognized as one of the best student Ambassador programs in the nation. Selected applicants will be contacted and invited to arrange an interview time. **Interviews will be scheduled for Tuesday, March 20, 2018 in McCarty Hall D room 2025.** The competitive selection process consists of several activities:

1. Applications will be reviewed and candidates will be selected for an interview. *You will be notified of our decision by email.*
2. You are required to submit a 1-2 minute snapchat/infomercial type video. Video quality is not a factor in this process; we simply want you to be creative and fun in “sharing your story as a student in CALS”. We encourage you to use your phone (or a friend’s) for this task. Nothing fancy just think creatively. Make sure your video **is oriented properly**. Submit your video via dropbox at ceMER@ufl.edu. This video must be submitted by the application deadline in order for your application to be complete.
3. As part of the interview process you will prepare a *three-minute engaging activity* that could be used with middle or high school students to promote the college, our majors, and other benefits of CALS. You may use visual aids or props such as game pieces, koosh balls, etc. to help in presenting the activity. **Electronic visual aids of any kind are prohibited. Highlight your creativity.** Treat this as you would a presentation to a group of prospective students.
4. Following your presentation, the selection panel will ask a series of questions.

Applicants *must*:

- Provide two **current** letters of recommendation. Each should reference your qualifications as a potential CALS Ambassador. (at least one from an academic advisor, professor, etc.).
- Be an entering sophomore, junior or senior (seniors must have a full year of availability: fall 2017 and spring 2018) enrolled in a major in the College of Agricultural and Life Sciences.
- **Attend the Ambassador Training Conference on August 13-15, 2018 – This is MANDATORY, meaning not negotiable. The conference requires 3 days and 2 nights out of town and one day on campus. The group will travel together, expenses and arrangements are handled by the CALS Dean’s Office. We will return to Gainesville on the afternoon of the 15th**
- **You will be expected to attend UF Freshman Convocation as your first official CALS Ambassador event on August 20th, 2018.**
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5.
- Be highly motivated, energetic, and dependable.
- Be able to demonstrate outstanding leadership skills.
- Be a team player.
- **Attend regularly scheduled bi-monthly meetings. MANDATORY unless you have a CLASS conflict.**
- Be willing to travel and participate in **evening and weekend activities**.

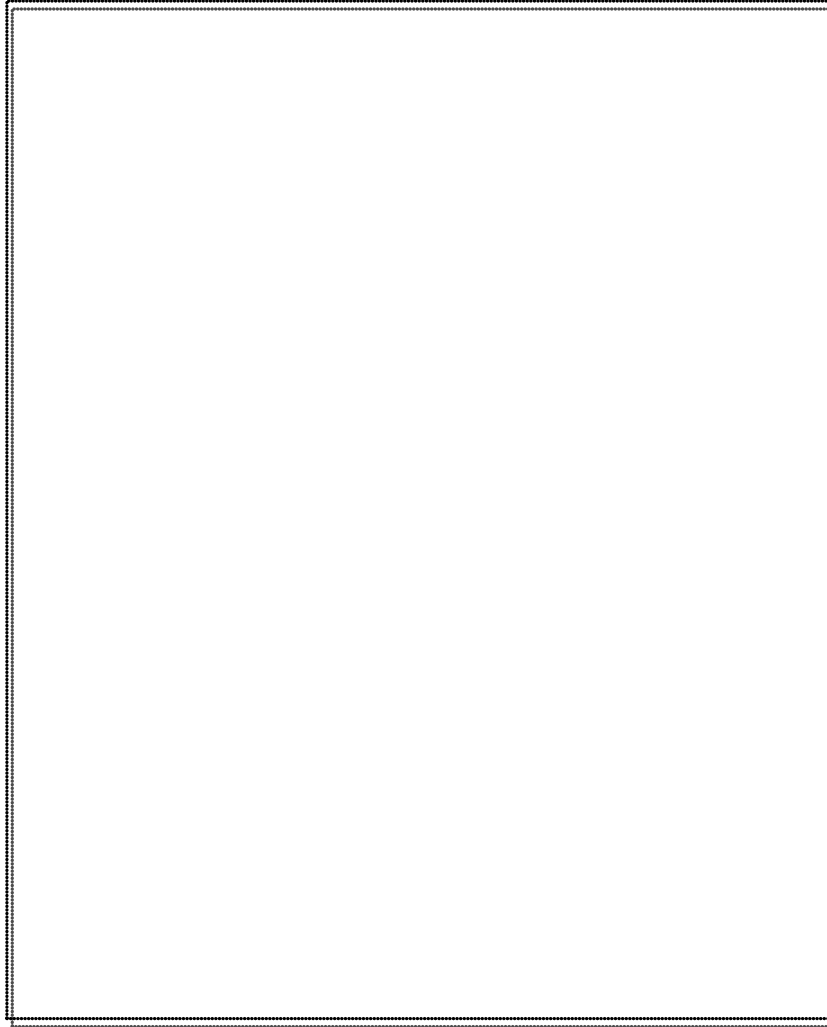
